SUB-TYPE: TN (Tree nutrition), SRC (Soil and root care), IDM (Insect and disease management)

* Pruning exceptions: Oaks and elms only scheduled October 1st through April 1st to prevent spread of oak wilt and Dutch elm disease, and birch are scheduled anytime except May 1st through July 1st to avoid attraction of Bronze birch borer.

** Some above grade girdling roots can be excised year-round, others that require air excavation are scheduled April 1st to October 1st.
